



Keystone[®] walls can readily be capped with a reinforced traffic barrier. Follow these procedures to install a poured concrete coping.

1. Install the Keystone[®] wall per general installation instructions.

2. Set and secure forming materials along the top course of the Keystone[®] wall using standard forming procedures. If the design requires an overhanging coping, form the edge using a "L" shaped galvanized iron or plastic forming material. Fasten this material to the top courses of the Keystone[®] wall. Pour and finish traffic barrier as by engineered design. Insert control joints at a maximum nine feet on center along the length of the coping, or as specified by engineer.
