2004 Circle of Design Excellence Award

Sponsored by Pittsburgh Corning, this program is to recognize those designs where glass block forms a prominent architectural feature of a building, either interior or exterior.

Eligibility:

Buildings must have been designed by architects licensed in the U.S. or Canada and must have been completed on or after January 1, 2002. They can be of any size and in any of the following categories: commercial, office, institutional, sports, education, governmental, healthcare, industrial, and single or multi-family residential. Both new buildings and renovations will be considered. More than one project may be submitted by the same firm and each submittal will be considered as a separate entry.

Awards:

Pittsburgh Corning management will judge project entrees. Awards will be presented recognizing projects in different regions throughout the U.S. and Canada and one National Award winner will be selected.



Each regional winner will receive:

- A) An award plaque of recognition;
- B) Posting of the project and design firm on the Pittsburgh Corning website;
- C) Hyperlink to architectural firms website.

The National Award winner will receive \$2,000 donated to a charity or scholarship of their choice.

 - 4" x 5" or 35mm transparencies (Acceptable format).
 - 8" x 10" glossy color prints (Minimal reguirement format).

■ Rights to photos and plans must be cleared for publication by the entrant. Any fees or royalties connected with such releases are the responsibility of the entrant. Owners must be informed of potential site visits and the significant media recognition that may occur.
